It is very important that the Beneficiary Reference used is the swimmers name and if we fetch a swimmer who attends the classes through a Nursery School that you add an abbreviation of the school name eg Dotty Day Care = "DDC".

Using only a first name or a surname, or perhaps a parents name does not help us to allocate the payment!

FEES

Fees are payable in two instalments during the term. The first payment is due by the end of the 1st month of the term, and the second payment is due by the 1st of the final month of the term.

So this term, 1st payment was due by 1 July and the last payment by 1st September 2021.

If you are paying the fees over 3 payments (having made the arrangements with the office, then the final payment for this term is due by 1st September 2021.

POPI ACT
